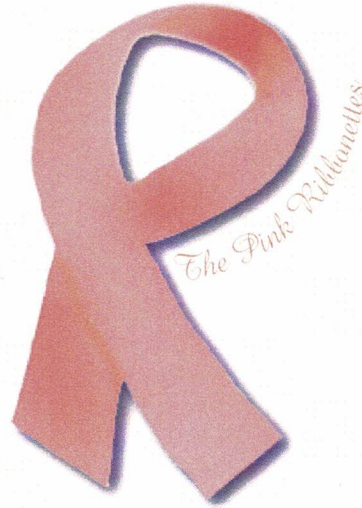

The Pink Ribbonettes are a local support group comprised of survivors dedicated to helping the newly diagnosed, their families and their caregivers. Through their individual experiences, our volunteers come together to share stories and offer hope to others going through breast cancer treatment.



*What do the  
Pink Ribbonettes do?*


When a man or woman is diagnosed with breast cancer, if they wish, one or two of our members will visit with them and offer information, support, and comfort during treatment. There are so many things that these survivors had to learn on their own during their treatment, they want to pass their knowledge on to new breast cancer patients to minimize some of the surprises and side effects they may experience. Newly diagnosed individuals receive a Pink Ribbonettes tote bag to carry with them during their visits for treatment, etc. Inside, there is a small pillow, a journal, pen and other helpful information on surviving cancer treatment, and navigating the journey to full recovery.
